Alleged Threat on Pensacola Catholic High School Community

Pensacola, FL — A student from Pensacola Catholic High School was arrested on Sunday night in connection with a threat of violence to the school community which was posted on social media. School officials became aware of the alleged threat Sunday night and immediately contacted local law enforcement. The Escambia County Sheriff's Office is currently investigating the matter.

“We became aware of a social media posting on Sunday night by one of our students which was regarding the safety of our school community,” said Sharmane Adams, spokeswoman for the diocese. “Safety and security is always a top priority and any threat is taken seriously.”

The student is no longer part of the school community and will not be returning to Pensacola Catholic High School.
