## Our history

The Lay Formation Institute was established by Bishop Gregory Parkes in 2015 and the first group began formation in August 2016.

Beginning in July 2018, we will partner with the University of Dayton's Virtual Learning Community for Faith Formation. Their many offerings will provide excellent formation for our church's future lay leaders.
